Andy Dunbobbin wedi ei ail-ethol fel CHTh gan bleidleiswyr y rhanbarth

Ar 2 Mai 2024, etholwyd Andy Dunbobbin o Lafur Cymru gan etholwyr Gogledd Cymru, i fod yn Gomisiynydd Heddlu a Throsedd (CHTh) am y pedair blynedd nesaf. Cafodd canlyniad yr etholiad ei ddatgan ar brynhawn 3 Mai ym Mhrifysgol Wrexham gan Ian Bancroft, Prif Weithredwr Cyngor Sir Bwrdeistref Wrexham a Swyddog Canlyniadau y Rhanbarth Heddlu.

Andy Dunbobbin re-elected North Wales PCC by voters of the region

On 2 May 2024 the voters of North Wales re-elected Andy Dunbobbin of Welsh Labour to be the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) for the next four years. The result of the election was declared on the afternoon of May 3 at Wrexham University by Ian Bancroft, Chief Executive of Wrexham County Borough Council and Police Area Returning Officer for the PCC election in North Wales.



Roedd pob pleidleisiwr dros 18 yn medru cymryd rhan yn yr etholiad, yr etholiad CHTh gyntaf i ddefnyddio'r system cyntaf-i'r felin, yn lle'r system flaenorol o bleidlais amgen.

Registered voters aged over 18 could take part in the election, which was the first PCC election conducted by the first-past-the-post system instead of the previous alternative vote method.

Andy Dunbobbin was first elected the Police and Crime Commissioner for North Wales in 2021. He is from Connah's Quay where he lives with his wife, son and daughter. He was previously a County Councillor

on Flintshire County Council for the Connah's Quay Golffryn ward but continues to be a member of Connah's Quay Town Council. Prior to his election, Mr Dunbobbin laid out his community orientated police service approach (COPS) to policing and his manifesto centred on four strategic pillars. These are a local neighbourhood policing presence; supporting victims, communities and businesses; a fair and effective criminal justice system; and a visible and responsive Police and Crime Commissioner.

The Commissioner has four main duties, which are to:

- Set out the priorities for policing in North Wales
- Decide the budget for North Wales Police
- Hold the Chief Constable to account, and to
- Listen and respond to the public's views on policing.



Dywedodd y Comisiynydd Heddlu a Throsedd Andy Dunbobbin: "Mae'n anrhydedd mawr i mi gael fy ail-ethol gan bobl Gogledd Cymru. Mae'n dangos eu bod yn hapus gyda'r gwaith rwyf wedi bod yn ei wneud dros y tair blynedd diwethaf i wneud plismona yn fwy effeithiol, effeithlon ac atebol. Police and Crime Commissioner of North Wales, Andy Dunbobbin, commented: "I feel immensely honoured to have been re-elected by the people of North Wales. It shows that they are happy with the work I have been doing over the last three years to make policing more effective, efficient and accountable. There is always more work we can do and I can't wait to get stuck back into serving all the people of North Wales, whether they voted for me or not. I would like to thank all who helped contribute to my campaign, my family, and the people of North Wales for the trust that have shown in me once again."

Ychwanegodd Prif Gwnstabl Heddlu Gogledd Cymru, Amanda Blakeman: “Hoffwn longyfarch y CHTh ar eu hetholiad. Fel heddlu, ein gweledigaeth ydy i Ogledd Cymru fod y lle mwyaf diogel yn y wlad i fyw, gweithio ac i ymweld – gweledigaeth ‘dwi’n gwybod bod y CHTh yn ei rannu. Rydym yn barod efo’r lefelau isaf o drosedd yn genedlaethol, ond mae wastad mwy i’w wneud i leihau trosedd ymhellach. ‘Rydw i’n edrych ymlaen at weithio efo’r CHTh yn y misoedd a’r blynnyddoedd dilynol drwy ymgynghoriad â thrigolion Gogledd Cymru.”
