

### Hate Crime Grants – October 2016

The North Wales Police and Crime Commissioner received £4,000 from Welsh Government to be spent on Hate Crime Awareness Week 2016. The OPCC gave some of that funding to the North Wales Community Cohesion Coordinators to allow local third sector organisations to bid for funds for events to mark Hate Crime Awareness Week.
