

Hate Crime Grants – October 2017

The North Wales Police and Crime Commissioner received £5,000 from Welsh Government to be spent on Hate Crime Awareness Week 2017. The OPCC gave some of that funding to the North Wales Community Cohesion Coordinators to allow local third sector organisations to bid for funds for events to mark Hate Crime Awareness Week and also used some of the funds to use directly on publicity material and other projects.
