Authentic Voices	£5,005.00	Contribution to deliver Freedom Programme to victims of Domestic Abuse across the region.
RASASC	£30,000.00	Contribution to support training to upskill staff and sessional workers, development of in house continuing professional development (CPD) and delivery and resources for online support.
Stepping Stones	£24,725.00	Contribution to support Own my Life training and SARP Training. The funding will also support the transition from Mental Health Services to Stepping Stones and Psychoeducation Resources.
Hafan Cymru	£37,200.00	Contribution to support continuing professional development (CPD) training and accreditation costs for professionals working within VAWDASV.
DASU	£75,951.00	Contribution to support various training courses across north Wales. The funding will also support a Flintshire Specialist Refuge Worker and a Conwy Community Specialist Domestic Abuse Worker.
