## Panel Heddlu a Throsedd yn cadarnhau Amanda Blakeman fel Prif Gwnstabl

Mewn cyfarfod ar 26 Medi o Banel Heddlu a Throsedd Gogledd Cymru yn adeilad Bodlondeb Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sir Conwy, cadarnhaodd aelodau mai Amanda Blakeman ydy Prif Gwnstabl newydd y rhanbarth. Ms Blakeman ydy'r Prif Gwnstabl benywaidd cyntaf yn hanes Heddlu Gogledd Cymru. Mae'n ymuno o Heddlu Gwent, lle roedd yn Ddirprwy Brif Gwnstabl.

Ymunodd Amanda Blakeman â Heddlu Gorllewin Mercia yn 1992 a thrwy gydol ei gyrfa, mae wedi cael sawl swydd. Treuliodd 11 mlynedd cyntaf ei gwasanaeth yn magu profiad a gwybodaeth amhrisiadwy ledled amrywiol rolau fel cwnstabl heddlu. Yn 2003 cafodd ei dyrchafu i fod yn rhingyll. ## Police and Crime Panel confirm Amanda Blakeman as Chief Constable

At a meeting on September 26 of the North Wales Police and Crime Panel at Conwy County Borough Council's Bodlondeb building, the members confirmed Amanda Blakeman as the region's new Chief Constable. Ms Blakeman is the first female Chief Constable in the history of North Wales Police and joins from Gwent Police, where she was Deputy Chief Constable.

Amanda Blakeman joined West Mercia Police in 1992 and throughout her career has held various posts. She spent the first 11 years of her service gaining an invaluable amount of experience and knowledge across a variety of roles as a police constable. In 2003 she was promoted to sergeant and, since then, across a number of ranks, has led teams in delivering critical services to communities.

## Innovate to Grow: First projects benefit from new scheme

The first two successful organisations to receive funding via a new scheme from North Wales Police and Crime Commissioner Andy Dunbobbin to help tackle crime were announced on 27 September.

RASASC NW (Rape and Sexual Abuse Support Centre North Wales), and young people's organisation, Youth Shedz, applied for funding from the Innovate to Grow initiative, which was unveiled by the PCC in April 2022 to target and invest in projects dealing with the root causes of crime across North Wales – especially ones that offer new and innovative ideas of preventing and tackling wrongdoing.
