Pawb yn Un dros Ogledd Cymru

Gwnaeth cynhadledd y cyntaf o'i bath ddigwydd yng Nghyffordd Llandudno ar 23 Tachwedd er mwyn edrych ar sut y gall asiantaethau a sefydliadau gwahanol, o'r heddlu i wasanaethau iechyd a chymdeithasol, ddod at ei gilydd i ymdrin ag achosion o drais domestig a chaethwasiaeth fodern yng Ngogledd Cymru.

Cynhaliwyd y digwyddiad, o'r enw Pawb yn Un, yng Nghanolfan Fusnes Conwy ac fe'i trefnwyd gan Swyddfa Comisiynydd Heddlu a Throsedd Gogledd Cymru (SCHTh), gan ychwanegu at waith Bwrdd Bregusrwydd a Chamfanteisio Gogledd Cymru yn yr ardal hon. Mae'r Bwrdd wedi cyhoeddi strategaeth hyd at 2024 gyda'r weledigaeth ganlynl: "Gall pobl Gogledd Cymru fyw bywydau diogel, cyfartal a rhydd o drais, mewn cymunedau heb ofn, cael eu cam-drin na'u camfanteisio."

All for One for North Wales

A first-of-its-kind conference took place in Llandudno Junction on 23 November to look at how different agencies and organisations from police through health and social services can come together to tackle cases of domestic violence and modern slavery in North Wales.

The event, called All for One, was held at the Conwy Business Centre and was organised by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for North Wales (OPCC), building on the work of the North Wales Vulnerability and Exploitation Board in this area. The Board has published a strategy up to 2024 with the vision that: "The people of North Wales can live safe, equal and violence-free lives, in communities without fear, abuse or exploitation."

The event was facilitated by Stephen Hughes, CEO, Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner and Chair of the North Wales Vulnerability and Exploitation Board. Keynote speakers included Nicole Jacobs, Domestic Abuse Commissioner for England and Wales; and ITV Presenter Ruth Dodsworth, who discussed her own experience of living in an abusive and coercive relationship. PCC urges the people of North Wales to have their say on police funding

North Wales Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC), Andy Dunbobbin, is asking the people of North Wales to make their voice heard on how much money they are prepared to pay for policing as part of a public consultation and survey.

As well as having their view on changes to the amount spent on policing, residents will also be able to say what priorities they want to see North Wales Police act on. The survey will also give them the chance to comment on how they see policing in their own community more generally. The poll can be filled in online and paper copies of the survey, in Welsh and English, are also available at libraries, police stations and some leisure centres across North Wales. Residents can also get the survey in Easy Read format.

The survey launches on 5 December 2022 and closes on the 11 January 2023.

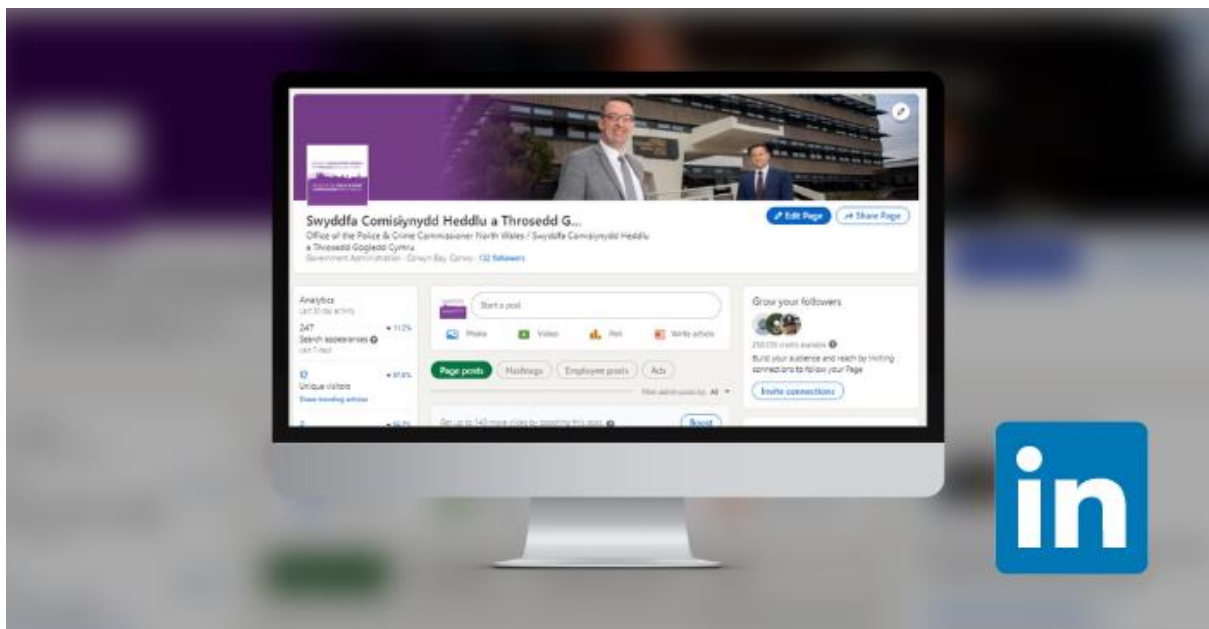
PCC shows support for campaign to end violence against women and girls
