Comisiynydd Heddlu a Throsedd yn taflu goleuni ar Heddlu Gogledd Cymru ar ran trigolion

Un o rolau allweddol Comisiynwyr Heddlu a Throsedd (CHTh) yng Nghymru a Lloegr ydy dwyn y Prif Gwnstabl yn atebol am gyflawniad yr Heddlu lleol o ran y blaenoriaethau yng Nghynllun Heddlu a Throsedd y CHTh. Mae'r cynllun hwn yn cael ei roi at ei gilydd mewn ymgynghoriad â thrigolion ac, yng Ngogledd Cymru, blaenoriaethau'r CHTh lleol Andy Dunbobbin ydy cyflawni cymdogaethau mwy diogel, system cyfiawnder troseddol deg ac effeithiol a chynorthwyo dioddefwyr a chymunedau.

Mae'r CHTh yn craffu gwaith Heddlu Gogledd Cymru drwy amrywiaeth eang o ffyrdd, gan gynnwys y Bwrdd Gweithredu Strategol. Yn y cyfarfod hwn, mae'r CHTh a'i dîm yn cyfarfod gyda'r Prif Swyddogion er mwyn adolygu cyflawniad yr Heddlu ar y cyfan, gan gynnwys o ran blaenoriaethau'r Cynllun Heddlu a Throsedd. Yn y cyfarfod diweddaraf, a fu ar 15 Chwefror, edrychodd y CHTh dros gyflawniad yr Heddlu o ran amlygrwydd, ymgysylltu a byrgleriaeth.

Police and Crime Commissioner puts North Wales Police under the spotlight

One of the key roles of Police and Crime Commissioners (PCCs) in England and Wales is holding the Chief Constable to account for the performance of the local Force against the priorities in the PCC's Police and Crime Plan. This plan is put together in consultation with local residents and, in North Wales, local PCC Andy Dunbobbin's priorities are delivering safer neighbourhoods, a fair and effective criminal justice system, and supporting victims and communities.

The PCC scrutinises the work of North Wales Police through a wide variety of ways, including the quarterly Strategic Executive Board. At this meeting the PCC and his team meet with the Chief Officers to review overall Force performance, including against the Police and Crime Plan priorities. At the most recent meeting, which took place on 15 February, the PCC reviewed the Force performance in respect of visibility and engagement, and burglary. [Read more here.](#)
