Background

This report is made in accordance with the Police and Crime Panel's statutory duty contained in Section 28(4) (d) of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011.

Review of the Police and Crime Commissioner's Annual Report

The North Wales Police and Crime Panel (PCP) considered the North Wales Police and Crime Commissioner's (PCC) Annual Report for 2017/18 at its meeting on 3 December 2018. The report was the PCC's second annual report and provided information on the policing priorities set by Mr. Arfon Jones.

The report also provided an overview and key achievements of the last year, information on the financial challenges and Mr. Jones' vision for the future as the PCC.

The PCP acknowledged the achievements of the last year and in particular welcomed the insight into 'A day in the life of North Wales Police', which summarised the incoming demand faced by the Force on a daily basis. In relation to the number of calls received in any one day, the PCP questioned how many calls related to mental health issues. The PCC agreed to include this information within his report

Recommendations

That the North Wales Police and Crime Panel accepts the Police and Crime Commissioner's Annual Report for 2017/18 subject to the inclusion of information, relating to the number of calls, which related to mental health issues.
