Review of the Police and Crime Commissioner's Annual Report

The North Wales Police and Crime Panel (PCP) considered the North Wales Police and Crime Commissioner's (PCC) Annual Report for 2018/19 at its meeting on 31 January 2020.

The report provided an update on overall progress against delivery of the Police and Crime Plan's strategic priorities. Whilst the PCC gave equal weight to all five strategic priorities, the overarching theme of 'reducing the criminal exploitation of vulnerable people' was introduced last year and was particularly highlighted throughout the report.
