## Response to a request under the Freedom of Information Act

Under the freedom of information act, please could I request:

- 1. A list of all collaboration agreements held in your force, including a brief summary of what they are for and with which forces the collaborative arrangement is with
- 2. Could you provide the value of benefits in terms of financial benefits, staff savings or efficiency savings of the collaboration
- 3. Could you please provide details of the officer (by rank if name cannot be provided) who is responsible for collaboration
- 4. A copy of any documents from 2020 to now which outlines the force commitment to a Wales wide collaboration.

## Response:

I can confirm that we do hold some of the information relating to collaboration. Section 1, Freedom of Information Act applied.
