THE RAPE AND SEXUAL SUPPORT CENTRE (RASASC)

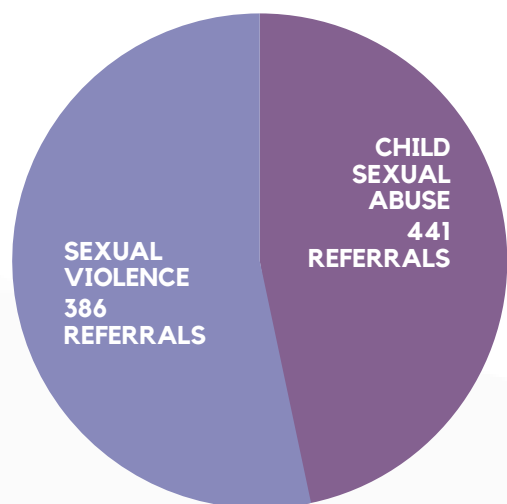

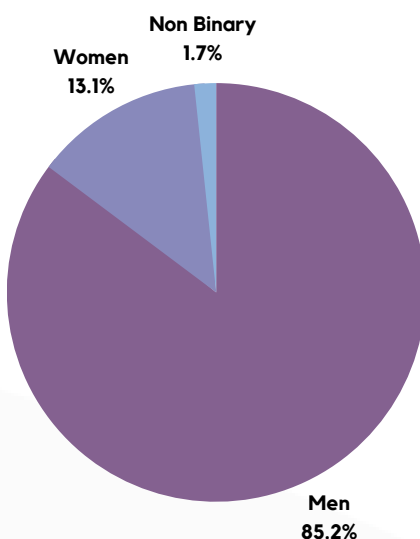

During 2021-22 RASASC received a total of **827** new referrals and have supported a total of **1192** clients.

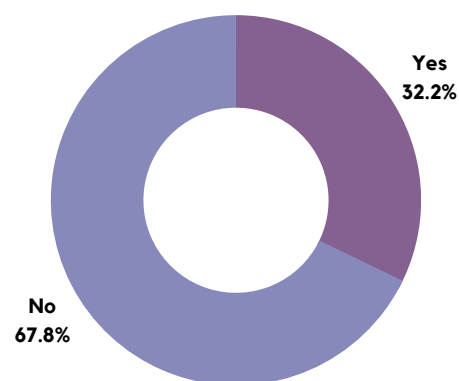
REFERRALS BY CRIME TYPE



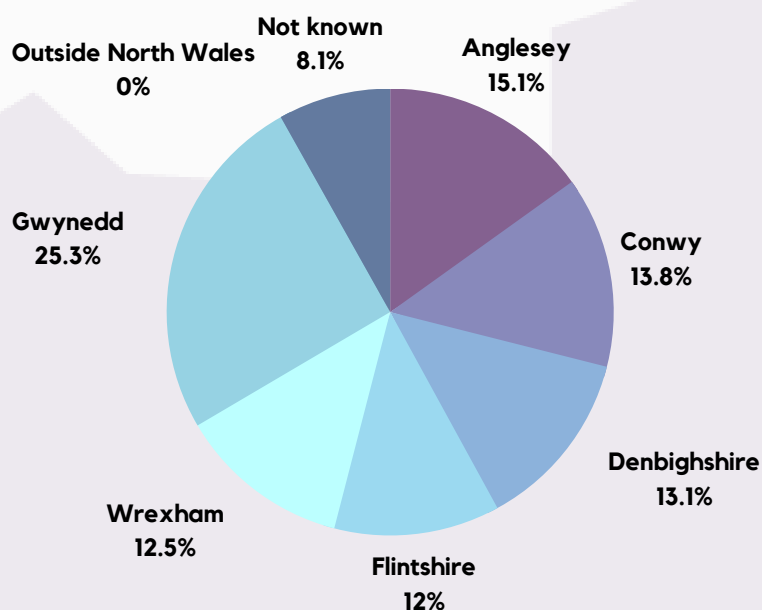
REFERRALS BY GENDER



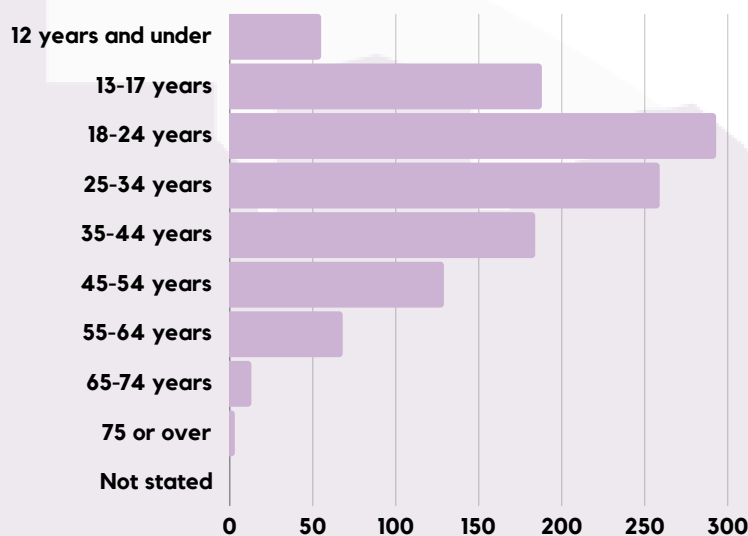
CLIENTS REPORTING THAT THEY ARE BETTER ABLE TO COPE WITH EVERYDAY LIFE

REGIONAL IDVA SERVICE

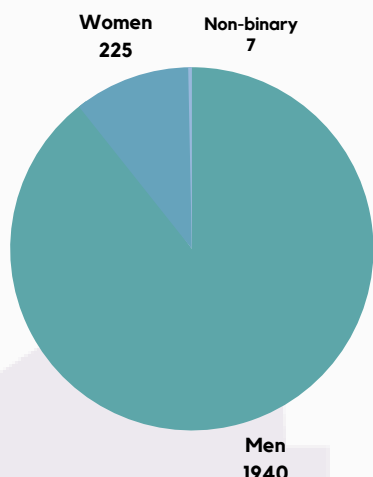

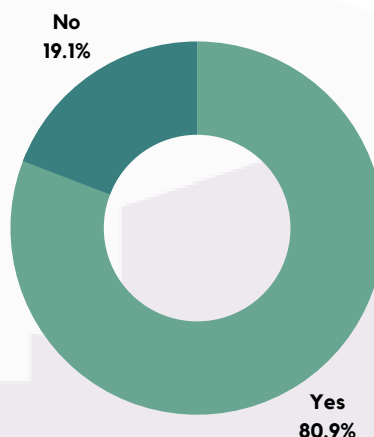

During 21/22 the Regional IDVA Service received a total of **1941** new referrals and supported a total of **2712** victims.

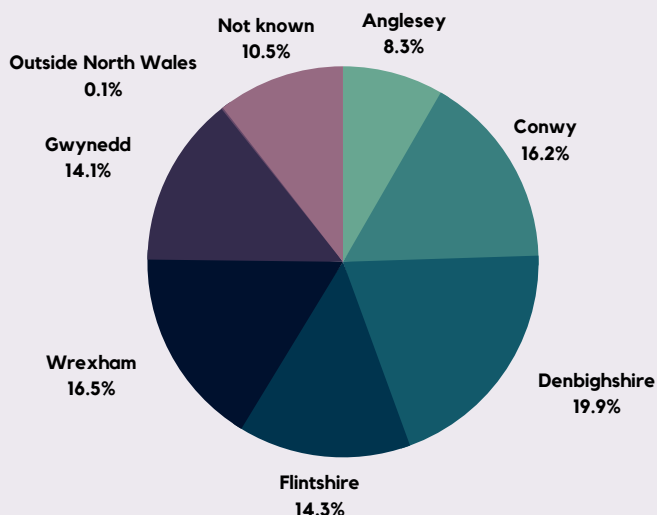
REFERRALS BY GENDER



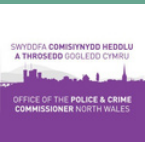
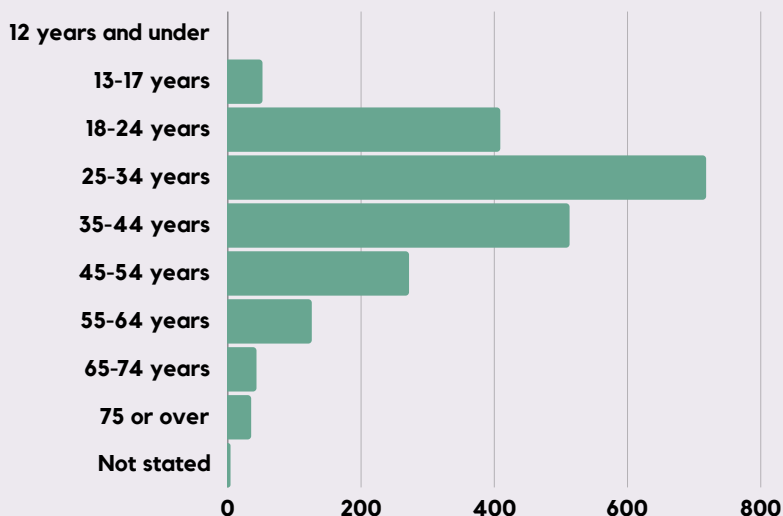

SEXUAL ASSAULT & RAPE CENTRE

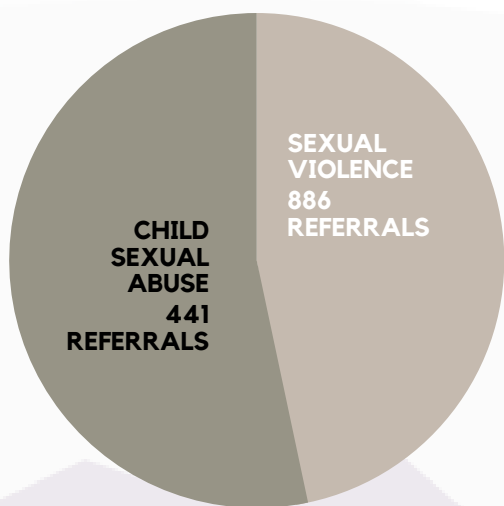

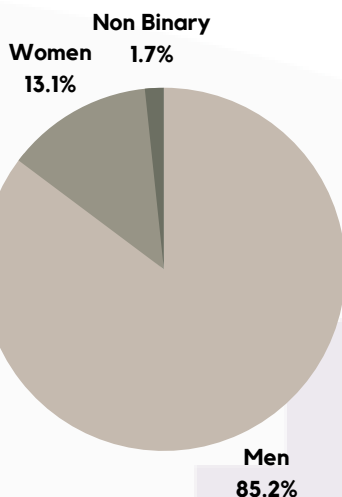

During 21/22 the SARC received **464** new referrals and supported a total of **634** clients.

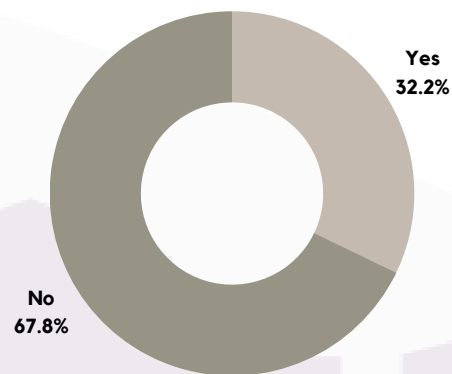
REFERRALS BY CRIME TYPE



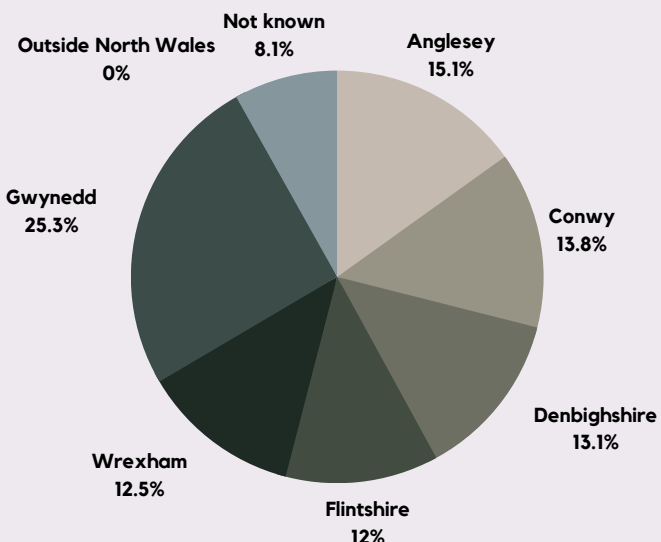
REFERRALS BY GENDER



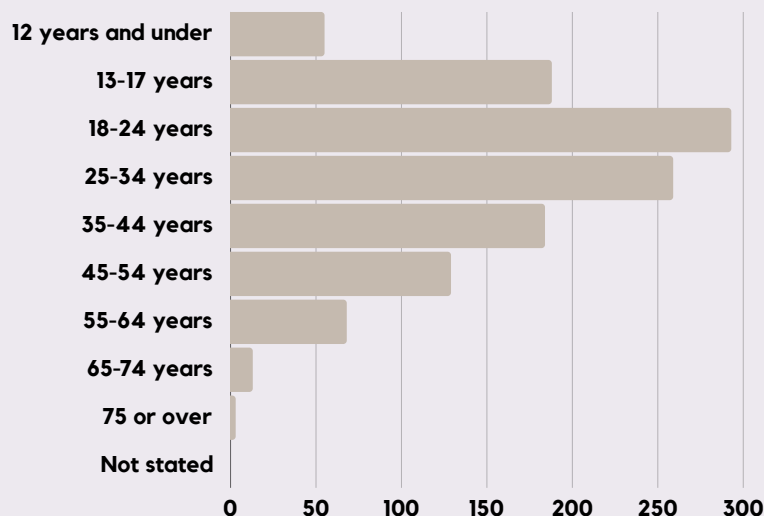
CLIENTS REPORTING THAT THEY ARE BETTER ABLE TO COPE WITH EVERYDAY LIFE

VICTIM HELP CENTRE (VHC)

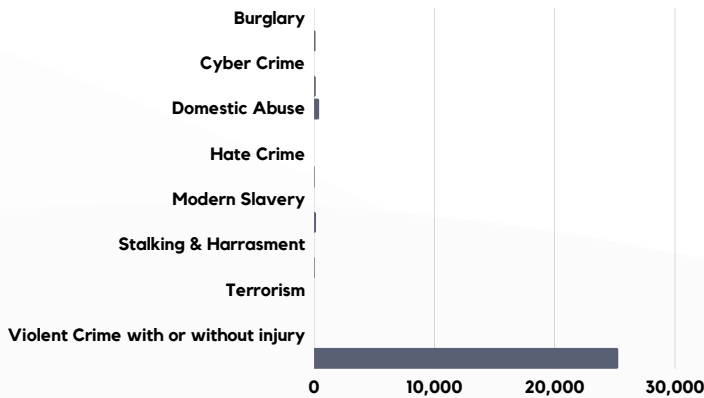

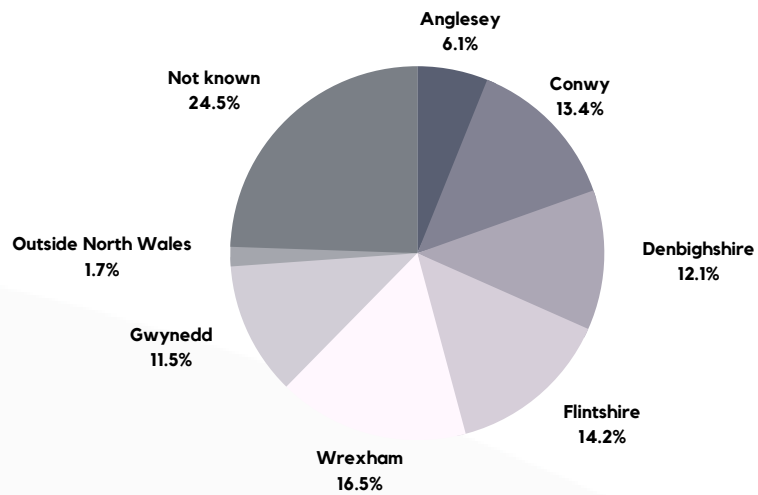

During 21/22 the Victim Help Centre received a total of **26,017** referrals. The Victim Help Centre supported **20,190** clients.

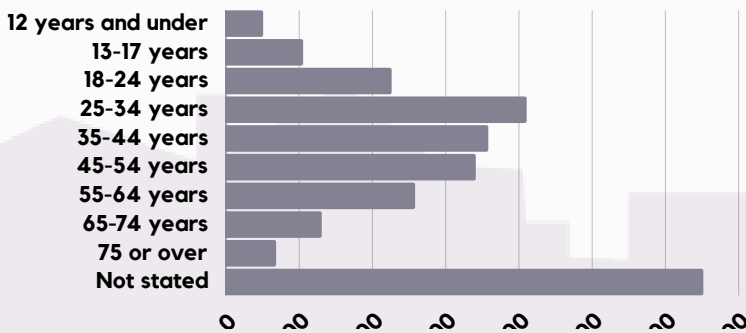
REFERRALS BY CRIME TYPE



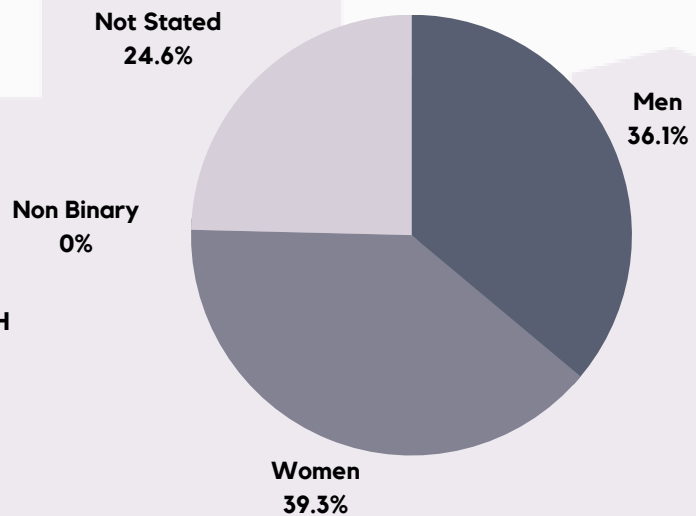
REFERRALS BY COUNTY
