## Response to a request under the Freedom of Information Act

### Response:

Two duties are placed on public authorities under Section 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). Notwithstanding applicable exemptions, the first duty at, Section 1(1) (a), is to confirm or deny whether the information specified in a request is held. The second duty at, Section 1 (1) (b), is to disclose information that has been confirmed as being held.

**1. Please can you supply me with ALL costs attributed to activities with LGBTQ, Pride, storytime in Libraries etc, Stonewall including man hours and costs/expenditure in relation to such activities for the last 5 years?**

I can confirm that information is held.

I can confirm that £1,500 has been contributed towards Pride events in the last 5 years. £64.57 has been spent to purchase Pride merchandise.

**2. Please can you supply FGM figures for the last 5 years and breakdowns by age of the victim?**

I can confirm that we do not hold this information.
