Ar 28 Medi, mi wnaeth y Comisiynydd Heddlu a Throsedd (CHTh) Andy Dunbobbin ymweld â Seren Ffestiniog Cyf (Seren) yn eu canolfan ym Mlaenau Ffestiniog i ddysgu mwy am sut mae arian o gronfa Eich Cymuned, Eich Dewis yn cael ei ddefnyddio i wella ansawdd bywyd pobl gydag anawsterau dysgu.

Mae Eich Cymuned, Eich Dewis yn dathlu ei degfed pen-blwydd yn 2023 a, dros y deng mlynedd diwethaf mae dros £500,000 wedi cael ei roi i dros 150 o brosiectau yn gweithio i leihau trosedd yn eu hardaloedd a chynorthwyo'r blaenoriaethau yng Nghynllun Trosedd Comisiynydd yr Heddlu.

PCC sees how community funding is projecting a positive future

On September 28, Police & Crime Commissioner Andy Dunbobbin visited Seren Ffestiniog Cyf (Seren) at their centre in Blaenau Ffestiniog to learn more about how funding from the Your Community, Your Choice fund is being used to further their work in enhancing the quality of life of those with learning disabilities.

Your Community, Your Choice is celebrating its tenth anniversary in 2023 and, over the past ten years, a total of over £500,000 has been awarded to more than 150 projects working to reduce crime in their areas and to support the priorities in the Police and Crime Commissioner's Police and Crime Plan

Established in 1996, Seren Ffestiniog Cyf is a charity that provides domiciliary, day and respite care for individuals with physical and learning disabilities in Gwynedd and has developed several projects, including offering work experience and employability skills within their day care service.

With the monies received from the Your Community, Your Choice funding, Seren have purchased an interactive projector to develop the dexterity, visual and mental skills of their service users. [Read more here.](#)

Mae Pentre Peryglon yn elusen annibynnol ar arfordir Gogledd Cymru. Roedd yn un o enillwyr diweddar gwobrau ariannu Eich Cymuned, Eich Dewis.

Mae'r arian o Eich Cymuned, Eich Dewis yn helpu'r Pentre Peryglon ddarparu sesiynau noddedig a chostau teithio i ysgolion ledled Gogledd Cymru. Fel y cyfryw, mae'r prosiect o fudd i blant 5 i 11 oed ynghyd ag oedolion bregus o chwe sir Gogledd Cymru. Mae'r sesiynau'n defnyddio senarios rhyngweithiol Pentre Peryglon er mwyn cyflawni ymweliadau sgiliau bywyd i 450 o blant a phobl ifanc. Mae'r prosiect yn defnyddio'r setiau ffilm gafaelgar er mwyn ymgysylltu hefo pobl ifanc yn y sgwrs o ran diogelwch cymunedol er mwyn eu helpu a'u gwarchod nhw.

Funding pot helps point the way to safety for young people

Andy Dunbobbin visited the home of DangerPoint in Talacre on 21 September to see the crucial work the organisation is doing to support the young people of North Wales and to see how money taken from criminals is being used for the good of the people of the region.


DangerPoint is an independent charity based on the North Wales Coast and was one of the winners of the latest Your Community, Your Choice funding awards.

The funding from Your Community, Your Choice is helping DangerPoint provide subsidised sessions and transport costs for schools across North Wales. As such, the project benefits young people aged 5 to 11 as well as vulnerable adults from all six counties in North Wales. The sessions make use of DangerPoint's interactive scenarios to deliver life skill visits for 450 children and young people. The project uses the immersive film sets to engage young people in the dialogue around community safety to support and protect them. [Read more here.](#)
